Park County Historical Archives Director Rhonda Spaulding requested a letter of support from the Board of County Commissioners endorsing a project titled "Old Trail Town: Worth Preserving?" for which they are seeking a \$8,000 – 9,000 grant from the American Association for State and Local History, in partnership with the History Channel.

Commissioner Shockley Siggins made a motion, seconded by French, to submit a letter of support on behalf of the Park County Archives for a grant application from the American Association for State and Local History, in partnership with the History Channel through the Save Our History program to create a video documentary titled, "Old Trail Town: Worth Preserving?". Motion carried.
