

**Park County Board of County Commissioners  
December 7, 2010  
Regular Meeting**

Proceedings of a regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of Park County, Wyoming, held Tuesday, December 7, 2010. Present were Chairperson Jill Shockley Siggins, Commissioners Tim French, Dave Burke, Bill Brewer and Bucky Hall, and County Clerk Kelly Jensen.

**Fair Board Interviews**

Commissioners interviewed Maynard Brown, R. Scott Heny and Robby Newkirk (incumbent) for one five-year term beginning January 1, 2011 on the Park County Fair Board. Commissioner Burke made a motion, seconded by French to reappoint Robby Newkirk to a five-year term on the Fair Board. Motion carried.

**Search and Rescue**

Sheriff Scott Steward addressed future plans for the Park County Search and Rescue program with the pending retirement of the program's administrator. The Sheriff sought authorization for the Homeland Security Coordinator to assist Search and Rescue on a part-time basis until the position is filled and fully trained by a Sheriff's Department employee. The work is not intended to interfere with Homeland Security duties. Commissioners supported the request without taking action.

**Request for Lighting at Park County Fairgrounds**

Denny and Shirley Benson asked the Board of County Commissioners to install lighting for the horse arena at the Park County Fairgrounds. Two other arena users offered volunteer assistance to install lighting. The Board stated a long-term electrical improvements plan is being developed by a consultant and will be shared with interested parties when it is available. No action was taken.

**Public Hearing – Budget Amendment**

Commissioner French made a motion, seconded by Brewer to open the public hearing to consider an amendment to the FY2011 Park County Budget. County Clerk Kelly Jensen outlined the proposed and advertised amendments.

Commissioner Hall made a motion, seconded by French to close the public hearing. Motion carried.

Commissioner Burke made a motion, seconded by French to amend the FY2011 budget approving **RESOLUTION 2010-58**, A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE FY11 PARK COUNTY BUDGET with the following amendments: transfer \$153,536.69 from the Forest Reserve funds to Park County Road and Bridge and increase General Fund reserves to reflect this transfer and increase Road and Bridge expenses to reflect this transfer; Increase General Fund Revenues by \$2,021.14 from closing the DARE account and increasing Sheriff's Department expenses by this amount; Increase Museum Board Revenues by \$4,354.00 from a grant and increase their expenses by this amount; Increase Library Board Revenues by \$41,696.00 from an endowment match and increase their expenses by this amount; Motion carried.

**DARE Account Closure**

Commissioner French made a motion, seconded by Brewer to close the DARE account. Motion carried.

**Approve Minutes**

Commissioner French made a motion, seconded by Hall to approve the minutes of the November 16, 2010 regular meeting. Motion carried.

**Vouchers**

Commissioner Hall made a motion, seconded by Burke to approve the vouchers presented for payment. Motion carried.

**TANF/CPI Grant Agreements**

Commissioner French made a motion, seconded by Burke to approve Grant Award Agreements with Yellowstone Behavioral Health (\$10,240), Children's Resource Center (\$10,000), West Park Hospital (\$7,020), Northwest Wyoming Family Planning (\$9,800), Crisis Intervention Services (\$15,085), Boys and Girls Clubs of Park County (\$25,000) and Powell Valley Healthcare (\$3,392) for Temporary Assistance for Needy Families/Community Partnership Initiative (TANF/CPI) funds. Motion carried.

### **Approve Bonds**

Upon recommendation of Park County Treasurer Nena Graham-Burke, Commissioner Burke made a motion, seconded by French to approve surety bonds for Lora Nordland (\$5,000) as Secretary-Treasurer of Shoshone Irrigation District, David Hoffert (\$2,500) as Secretary-Treasurer of Clark Fire District, Loren Grosskopf (\$1,000) as Park County Commissioner, Edna Myers (\$10,000) as Secretary-Treasurer of Meeteetse Cemetery District and Frances Lili Turnell (\$10,000) as Treasurer of the Meeteetse Museum Board. Motion carried.

### **4-H Educator Update**

University of Wyoming, Cooperative Extension agent Tara Kuipers informed the Board the Park County 4-H Educator has resigned her position. Kuipers will work with University of Wyoming Human Resource staff to post the position and seek qualified candidates to serve in the position. No action was taken.

### **Park County Complex Phase II Bid Award**

Buildings and Grounds Superintendent Dennis Spargur recommended the low bid from Cowan Construction of Cody. Commissioner Hall made a motion, seconded by Burke to award the low bid for Phase II of the Park County Complex improvements to Cowan Construction of Cody in the amount of \$1,150,000. Motion carried.

### **Construction Contracts**

Commissioner French made a motion, seconded by Hall to approve and allow the Chair to sign a contract with John Stott in the amount of \$7,682.00 for painting at the Powell Branch Library. Motion carried.

Commissioner Hall made a motion, seconded by Brewer to approve and allow the Chair to sign a contract with Big Horn Carpet One in the amount of \$30,315.00 for carpeting at the Powell Branch Library. Motion carried.

### **Cody Shooting Complex Land Patent**

Cody Shooting Complex Board President Karen Spearing and Mike Stewart with the Bureau of Land Management announced a patent for 292 acres transferring ownership from the federal government to Park County for the Cody Shooting Complex. Spearing asked the Board to renew and consider extending the term of the lease to five years. County Attorney Bryan Skoric recommended not entering into a five-year lease to avoid extending the agreement to future boards.

### **Cody Shooting Complex Lease Discussion**

Commissioner French made a motion, seconded by Hall to extend the term of the lease for the Cody Shooting Complex for five years with the County Attorney modifying the language of the lease to meet current status. Voting in favor of the motion were Commissioners Hall, French and Siggins. Commissioners Brewer and Burke were opposed. Motion carried.

### **Park County Parks and Recreation Board**

Park County Parks and Recreation Board member John Krebs asked the Board to consider funding in the amount of \$700 for the Board's annual holiday celebration for board members and a guest.

Commissioner Hall made a motion to allow Park County Parks and Recreation Board to spend up to \$500 for an annual holiday dinner, with no alcohol purchases. The motion died for lack of a second.

Krebs also asked the Board if they could spend funds to recognize and honor retiring long-time Board volunteer Lyn Ackerman, who is going off the Board the end of this year. The Board suggested Krebs review Park County's recognition program for outgoing long-term employees for possible ideas. No action was taken.

### **Little America Contract**

Commissioner Hall made a motion, seconded by Burke to approve a contract with Little America to pay for a proportionate share of the costs for a dinner with the County Commissioners and legislators from the four regional counties. Voting in favor were Hall and Burke. Opposed were Commissioners Brewer, French and Siggins. Motion failed.

### **Whitlock II Subdivision Amended Plat**

County Planner Linda Gillett presented the application of Erik Petersen for an amendment of Whitlock II Subdivision to adjust Lots 2 and 3 down to one acre each,

and enlarge Lot 4 to 2.75 acres, within Whitlock II Subdivision, Lots 2, 3 and 4, T55N, R99W, 6<sup>th</sup> P.M., Park County, Wyoming in the GR-P zoning district.

Commissioner French made a motion, seconded by Hall to approve **RESOLUTION 2010-59, APPROVAL OF AN AMENDED PLAT FOR THE WHITLOCK II SUBDIVISION.** Motion carried.

**Sessions Minor Subdivision Amended Plat**

County Planner Linda Gillett presented the application of Trenton and Brenda Sessions, Shane and Stephanie Shoopman, and Timothy and Sarah Wormald for an amendment to Sessions SS-129 to enlarge Lot 1 through boundary line relocation with Remainder Lot A, where Lot 1 is now 7.45 acres from 2.45; remainder Lot A is reduced by enlargement of Lot 1.1, and enlargement of family transfer parcel Lot B.1 from 4.87 acres to 10.59 acres, located within Lot 63-O and a portion of Lot 63-P, T55N, R98W, 6<sup>th</sup> P.M., Park County, Wyoming in the GR-P zoning district.

Commissioner Burke made a motion, seconded by French to approve **RESOLUTION 2010-60, APPROVAL OF AN AMENDED PLAT FOR THE SESSIONS SS-129 SUBDIVISION.** Motion carried.

**Peaks Minor Subdivision Final Plat**

Assistant County Planner Becky Conrad presented the application of Jeff and Roxane Sheridan for a Final Plat for a three-lot Minor Subdivision for single family residential use consisting of 2.6 acres, 2.32 acres and 30.06 acres from 34.98 acres within Lot 62-C, T55N, R99W, 6<sup>th</sup> P.M., Park County, Wyoming at 970 Road 8 in the GR-P zoning district.

Commissioner Bill made a motion, seconded by French to approve **RESOLUTION 2010-61, APPROVAL OF THE FINAL PLAT FOR THE PEAKS MINOR SUBDIVISION** with the requested relief granted. Motion carried. Voting in favor were Commissioners Hall, Brewer and French. Opposed was Commissioner Burke. Motion carried.

**Dent/Loloff Simple Subdivision**

Assistant County Planner Becky Conrad presented the application of Jeff and Beverly Dent have proposed creating a one-lot simple subdivision for single family residential use consisting of a 10-acre Lot with a 88.25-acre exempt remainder parcel within SW1/4 SE1/4, Section 3 (Resurvey), T54N, R98W, 6<sup>th</sup> P.M., Park County, Wyoming in the GR-P zoning district.

Commissioner Burke made a motion, seconded by Hall to approve **RESOLUTION 2010-62, APPROVAL OF THE SKETCH PLAN FOR THE DENT/LOLOFF SIMPLE SUBDIVISIONS-198.** Motion carried.

**Park County Parks and Recreation Board**

Commissioner Brewer made a motion, seconded by Hall, to appoint Incumbents Duane Farley and Coleen Metzler and D. Lincoln Reese to serve five-year terms beginning January 1, 2011 to the Park County Parks and Recreation Board. Motion carried.

**Park County Planning and Zoning Commission**

Commissioners interviewed Nancy Bailey, Thomas Flack and Ann Trosper for two three-year terms on the Park County Planning and Zoning Commission, beginning January 1, 2011. Commissioner Hall made a motion, seconded by French to appoint Nancy Bailey and Tom Flack to three-year terms on the Park County Planning and Zoning Commission. Motion carried.

**Executive Session**

Commissioner Hall made a motion, seconded by Burke to go into executive session pursuant to 16-4-405(a)(ix), matters confidential by law. Motion carried. Commissioner Hall made a motion, seconded by French to go out of executive session. Motion carried.
