

**Park County Board of County Commissioners  
August 9, 2011  
Regular Meeting**

A regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of Park County, Wyoming, was held on Tuesday, August 9, 2011. Present were Chairman Bucky Hall, Commissioners Loren Grosskopf, Dave Burke, Joe Tilden and County Clerk, Jerri Torczon. Tim French was absent from the meeting.

Chairman Bucky Hall called the meeting to order and led the audience in the pledge of allegiance.

**Presentation of Viewer's Report for Petition to Vacate Portion of Railway Street in Ralston.**

Mike Collier, Project Manager, presented the Viewer's Report for the Petition of Alan and Charlotte Lynn to Vacate Portion of Railway Street in Ralston, as the homeowners cannot obtain a clear title due to existing encroachments and the need to replace the septic system which would extend into a portion of the alley. The viewer's report was prepared at the direction of the Board of County Commissioners and recommended vacation of a portion of Railway Street and alley adjacent to Lot 4, Block 8, of the Original Townsite of Ralston. After a general discussion, it was moved by Commissioner Tilden, seconded by Commissioner Grosskopf and unanimously carried to accept the viewer's report and to proceed with the vacation process.

It was then moved by Commissioner Tilden, seconded by Commissioner Burke and unanimously carried to require a \$750.00 bond to be paid by the applicants for expenses that may be incurred during the vacation of the street.

**Discussion of Bureau of Land Management Big Horn Basin Draft Resource Management Plan and Draft Environmental Impact Statement.**

A discussion was held whether to release the draft response regarding the Bureau of Land Management Big Horn Basin Draft Resource Management Plan and Draft Environmental Impact Statement. It was the consensus of the Board to have Ecosystem Research Group (ERG) release the draft executive summary, upon the concurrence of the other cooperators.

**Approval of Letter Regarding Wilderness Designations within Park County.**

A draft letter to the Wyoming State Office of the Bureau of Land Management regarding the Wilderness Designations within Park County was presented to the Board for their consideration. After a general discussion, it was moved by Commissioner Grosskopf and seconded by Commissioner Tilden to approve the letter as drafted opposing any additional Wilderness Study Areas in Park County. Roll was called with Commissioner Burke casting the only dissenting vote. Motion carried.

**Approval of Bonds.**

Treasurer Barb Poley presented bonds for the Board's consideration. It was moved by Commissioner Tilden, seconded by Commissioner Grosskopf and unanimously carried to approve the bonds for S. Joseph Darrah, in the amount of \$20,000.00, as the Treasurer for the Clarks Fork Irrigation District and for Tonya Lowham, in the amount of \$40,000.00, as the Treasurer for the Park County Library System.

**Approval of Minutes.**

Minutes of the regular meeting of August 2, 2011 were presented to the Commissioners for their consideration. It was moved by Commissioner Grosskopf, seconded by Commissioner Tilden and unanimously carried to approve the minutes as presented.

**Adjournment.**

It was moved by Commissioner Burke, seconded by Commissioner Tilden and unanimously carried to adjourn the meeting.
