

**Park County Board of County Commissioners
Special Meeting
July 26, 2016**

Chairman French called to order a special meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of Park County, Wyoming, on Tuesday, July 26, 2016. Present were Chairman Tim French, Vice Chairman Lee Livingston, Commissioners Bucky Hall, Joe Tilden, and Deputy County Clerk Teecee Barrett.

Commissioner Hall led the audience in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Review Quotes-Andy Martin Hill Project.

Brian Edwards, County Engineer, and Jeremy Quist, Staff Engineer, presented bids for the earth work to finish the Andy Martin Hill project. Bids were received from Nicholson Dirt Contracting and Harris Trucking for the earthwork to construct the road corridor and crush gravel base for the road. Nicholson submitted the low bid of \$112,417.55. Harris Trucking also submitted a quote to provide hot mix asphalt for the three-inch thick mat surface. Harris quoted \$62.00/ ton for 860 tons. The staff estimated that striping, seeding, drainage and erosion control would cost an additional \$43,400.00. Commissioner Livingston moved to approve the recommendation from the staff to award the earthwork to Nicholson Dirt and the hot mix quote to Harris Trucking with total authorized of \$209,137.55. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Hall and unanimously carried. The road is planned to be closed from August 1, 2016 to September 15, 2016. The improvements will be substantially completed during this time period.

Adjourn.

Commissioner Hall made a motion to adjourn, Commissioner Tilden seconded and the motion carried.
