

RESOLUTION 2017-__

PARK COUNTY, WYOMING

(Licensed Building Restrictions, Hours of Operation)

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners is permitted pursuant to Wyo. Stat. §12-5-101(d) to set hours of operation for alcohol sales in the unincorporated areas of Park County, provided that the hours of operation are uniformly applied to establishments similiary situated; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Wyo. Stat. §12-5-201 the Board of County Commissioners may regulate minors presence in a licensed building.

NOW THEREFORE, having duly met at a regular meeting and considered the matter, it is

RESOLVED, Licensees may begin alcoholic or malt beverage sales in the licensed building at 6:00 a.m. and shall close the sale of both alcoholic and malt beverages promptly at the hour of 2:00 a.m. the following day. In addition, licensees shall clear the licensed building of all persons other than bona fide employees by 2:30 a.m.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED THAT, Except as provided below, no licensee or agent, employee, server thereof shall knowingly permit any person under the age of twenty-one (21) years to enter or remain in the licensed building with the following exceptions:

- 1) Those establishments holding a restaurant license, limited retail licenses (clubs, guest ranch, golf course), resort license, catering permits are exempt from age restrictions as to presence of minors on the licensed premises.
- 2) Except as provided otherwise by law, no licensee or agent, employee or server thereof shall permit any person under the age of twenty-one (21) years to enter or remain in the licensed building where alcoholic or malt beverages are being dispensed in an establishment that is primarily intended for on-premise consumption of alcoholic and malt beverages. If the establishment operates a commercial kitchen, persons under the age of twenty-one (21) years may enter and remain in a dining room or waiting area in a licensed building when accompanied by an adult and not later than 10:00 p.m., but not including seating at the bar itself.
- 3) No person under the age of 21 may dispense alcoholic of malt beverages.
- 4) Employees 18 to 21 years of age may serve alcohol or malt bevarges while the commercial kitchen is open but no later than 10:00 p.m.
- 5) Establishments that operate primarily for off-premise consumption (package liquor) shall maintain a separate area for the sale of alcoholic or malt beverages and comply with Wyo. Stat. §12-6-101(c)(vi).
- 6) Violations of this Resolution may be cited by the County Sheriff pursuant to Wyo. Stat. §12-8-101, which carries a penalty of a fine of not more than \$750.00, imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both. Also, any citation issued under this Resolution shall be reported by the County Sheriff to the County Clerk for review before the Board of County Commissioners at each annual license renewal.
