**THE POWELL LANDFILL IS
NOW A DRY LANDFILL.**

What is a dry landfill?

It means we cannot accept "wet" or household garbage and electronics. Anything that has had any contact with foodstuffs, can putrefy, attract scavengers or blow in the wind. Electronics include computers, monitors, televisions, cell phones, etc. **These items must be collected into a bin that is hauled to a lined facility.** Most other wastes that you normally bring to the landfill are acceptable. Ask gate attendant for a detailed list.

Powell is not expected to close completely on the condition that it collects enough revenue in gate fees to meet its expenses.

Certified scales are used to weigh each delivery in and out of the facility. Your disposal charge is based on the weight of your delivered wastes.

Landfill Procedures

All vehicles are required to register with the Landfill Gate Attendant to receive delivery instructions for every load. You must obey all speed limit signs especially while taking turns entering and exiting the scale.

Please follow the gate attendant's instructions. If you have a question please obtain help from one of the site employees. Operations and disposal areas at the facilities change often. We are here to help.

Yield to Landfill equipment. You can see them better than they can see you. Be cognizant of your surroundings.

During inclement weather please call to make sure areas of disposal are open.

Motor vehicles for scrap are accepted but **all the liquids must be drained** from the vehicle.

All waste brought to the landfill must be secured, covered or in a closed container. Any load arriving at the landfill gate not properly secured will be subject to a **\$25** surcharge or refusal to accept material for disposal.

All vehicles must be safely unloaded and returned to gate before closing time.

How to Report Illegal Dumping

It is best to call the local law enforcement immediately.

Random Waste Screening

For continued protection of our landfills, random load inspections are also required by our governing agencies. The US Environmental Protection Agency, E.P.A., R.C.R.A Sub Title "D" Procedures for excluding hazardous waste, regulatory overview (40 CFR, Part 258.20) requires these inspection and documentations of incoming loads to detect hazardous or PCB Waste. **If your load is chosen for random inspection, your patience is appreciated.**

It is unlawful to scavenge or salvage without written approval

Hazardous Waste

It is unlawful to dispose any liquid, chemical or regulated hazardous material at a municipal landfill. Special wastes such as NON-Friable Asbestos (Friable Asbestos not accepted), Paint, Oil, Batteries, Refrigerators, Air Conditioners or other hazardous materials require special handling. Please contact the Landfill Gate Attendants **BEFORE** delivering these items to the landfill.

Petroleum Contaminated Soil (PCS)

is accepted at the Powell Landfill only. Fees are based on \$20/ton with a minimum charge of \$400. Prior approval with an Agreement for Proper Analytical Testing is required. Contact the Landfill Office (307) 754-1818.
